

Cornell Seymour Scholarship

The Cornell Seymour Scholarship will be awarded to an eligible student in the year 2026 as administered by the Mt Calvary Baptist Church. The amount of this scholarship is \$1,500.00 and is separate from other scholarships offered at Mt Calvary.

The committee has placed emphasis on applicants having active membership at Mt. Calvary and participating in various ministries where possible.

The essay must consist of 350 to 500 words, typed and double-spaced, using basic font (Times New Roman, Calibri, Arial).

The entire application package must be submitted to the church office by **May 3, 2026**. Details can be found on the church's website on the announcements page.

Student Eligibility:

- Must be an active member of Mt Calvary Baptist Church (attend church regularly, participate in Bible Study, participate in Church School, participate in ministry)
- Must be a full-time student in school, ranking from High School Senior to Junior in Undergrad College.
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or above on the 4.0 scale as of Jan 1, 2026
- Must submit a letter of recommendation from a school leader (i.e., teacher, counselor, professor)
- Must submit a letter of recommendation from a Mt. Calvary ministry leader (i.e., Deacon, Trustee, Ministry Leader)
- Must submit an essay based on the subject:

1. How do you stay spiritually and physically connected with your church?
2. As you matriculate to higher academia, the number of distractions will increase. How do you, as a student, maintain your connection to Christ and the church in the face of those distractions?
